### Opioid facts<sup>1</sup>

- Opioids are used to treat moderate-to-severe pain.
- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention say they are not usually helpful for long-term use.

#### **Opioid safety**

To help make sure you stay safe, we:

- Restrict your first prescription to a 7-day supply.<sup>2,3</sup>
- Limit refill amounts.<sup>3</sup>
- Help ensure use of short-acting opioids first.<sup>3</sup>
- Offer counseling with CVS Pharmacy® pharmacists.
- For pain that lasts less than one month, opioids should be taken only as long as needed while pain is severe. Often, just a few days or fewer are enough.

#### We help you understand safe use1,2

We help make sure you know how to take opioids safely and correctly. Follow these tips to stay as safe as possible:

- Take medication exactly as instructed by your doctor.
- · Never share your opioids with others.
- Avoid alcohol and certain medications that are unsafe with opioids.
- Review your medications with your doctor or pharmacist regularly.
- Keep any opioids in a secure place. Lock them up, if possible.
